## A BILL

To amend the Aviation and Transportation Security Act to extend the suspended service ticket honor requirement.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Aviation Consumer  
5 Protection Extension Act of 2006”.

6 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF REQUIREMENT FOR AIR CARRIERS**  
7 **TO HONOR TICKETS FOR SUSPENDED AIR**  
8 **PASSENGER SERVICE.**

9 Section 145(c) of the Aviation and Transportation  
10 Security Act (49 U.S.C. 40101 note) is amended by strik-

1 ing “November 19, 2005.” and inserting “November 30,  
2 2007.”.
