A BILL

To temporarily suspend the duty on certain reception apparatus.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN RECEPTION APPARATUS NOT CON-**
4 **TAINING A CLOCK OR CLOCK TIMER, INCOR-**
5 **PORATING FM OR AM/FM RADIO ONLY.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
7 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
8 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
9 new heading:

“	9902.85.28	Reception apparatus for radiotelephony, radiotelegraphy or radio broadcasting, not containing a clock or clock timer, incorporating fm or am/fm radio only (provided for in sub-heading 8527.19.50)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2009	”.
