A BILL

To extend the temporary suspension of duty on electrical radio broadcast receivers not combined with a clock.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ELECTRICAL RADIO BROADCAST RECEIVERS**

4 **NOT COMBINED WITH A CLOCK.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.02.25 of the Har-
6 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
7 electrical radio broadcast receivers not combined with a
8 clock) is amended by striking “12/31/2006” and inserting
9 “12/31/2009”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
4 the date of enactment of this Act.
