3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN STANDARD LAMINATE WOOD MOLD-**
4 **ING MEASURING LESS THAN 8-FEET IN**
5 **LENGTH BUT GREATER THAN 4-FEET IN**
6 **LENGTH.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
8 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
