A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on certain laminate wood floor molding, other than standard molding, less than 4-feet in length but greater than 3-feet in length.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN LAMINATE WOOD FLOOR MOLDING,**
4 **OTHER THAN STANDARD MOLDING, LESS**
5 **THAN 4-FEET IN LENGTH BUT GREATER**
6 **THAN 3-FEET IN LENGTH.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
8 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is

1 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
 2 new heading:

“ 9902.44.11	Certain laminate wood floor molding, other than standard molding, less than 4-feet in length but greater than 3-feet in length (provided for in subheading 4411.29.90)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2009	”.

3 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by
 4 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
 5 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
 6 the date of the enactment of this Act.
