## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on certain aramid chopped fiber.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN ARAMID CHOPPED FIBER.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
7 new heading:

“	9902.90.30	Chopped synthetic staple fibers, containing 50 percent or more by weight of aramid fibers (provided for in sub-heading 5503.10.90), the foregoing impregnated with adhesives for bonding such fibers to rubber .....	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2009	”.

1       (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
2 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or  
3 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after  
4 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
