A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on other footwear with outer soles of rubber, plastics, leather or composition leather and uppers of leather, valued not over \$2.50 per pair.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. OTHER FOOTWEAR WITH OUTER SOLES OF**
4 **RUBBER, PLASTICS, LEATHER OR COMPOSI-**
5 **TION LEATHER AND UPPERS OF LEATHER,**
6 **VALUED NOT OVER \$2.50 PER PAIR.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
8 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is

1 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
 2 new heading:

“	9902.64.03	Other footwear with outer soles of rubber, plastics, leather, or composition leather and uppers of leather, valued not over \$2.50 per pair, the foregoing not covering the ankle other than house slippers and other than footwear (provided for in subheading 6403.99.75)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2009	”.

3 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
 4 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
 5 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
