A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on numerous other seals made of rubber or silicone, and covered with, or reinforced with, a fabric material.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. NUMEROUS OTHER SEALS MADE OF RUBBER**
4 **OR SILICONE, AND COVERED WITH, OR REIN-**
5 **FORCED WITH, A FABRIC MATERIAL.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
7 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
8 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
9 new heading:

“	9902.59.11	Numerous other seals made of rubber or silicone, and covered with, or reinforced with, a fabric material (provided for in subheading 5911.90.00)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2009	”.

1 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by
 2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
 3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
