## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on ski boots, cross country  
ski footwear and snowboard boots.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF CERTAIN EXISTING DUTY SUS-**

4 **PENSIONS AND REDUCTIONS.**

5 (a) OTHER MODIFICATIONS.—

6 (1) SNOWBOARD BOOTS.—Heading 9902.64.04  
7 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United  
8 States is amended—

1           (A) by striking “Snowboard” and inserting  
2           “Ski boots, cross country ski footwear and  
3           snowboard”;

4           (B) by striking “4%” and inserting  
5           “Free”; and

6           (C) by striking “12/31/2006” and inserting  
7           “12/31/2009”.

8           (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendments made by  
9           subsection (a) apply to goods entered, or withdrawn from  
10          warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after  
11          the date of the enactment of this Act.
