## A BILL

To provide for the duty-free entry of certain tramway cars and associated spare parts for use by the city of Seattle, Washington.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN TRAMWAY CARS AND ASSOCIATED**  
4 **SPARE PARTS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Commissioner of Customs  
6 shall admit free of duty 3 tramway cars (provided for in  
7 subheading 8603.10.00 of the Harmonized Tariff Sched-  
8 ule of the United States) manufactured in Ostrava, Czech  
9 Republic, for the use by the city of Seattle, Washington  
10 and imported pursuant to a contract with the city of Se-

1 atle, Washington, and associated spare parts for such  
2 tramway cars (provided for in applicable subheadings of  
3 heading 8607 or other headings of the Harmonized Tariff  
4 Schedule of the United States) imported pursuant to such  
5 contract, the foregoing to be entered into the customs ter-  
6 ritory of the United States not later than December 31,  
7 2007.

8 (b) RELIQUIDATION.—If the liquidation of the entry  
9 of any article described in subsection (a) has become final  
10 before the date of enactment of this Act, the entry shall,  
11 notwithstanding any other provision of law, be reliquidated  
12 in accordance with the provisions of this section and ap-  
13 propriate refund of duty made at the time of reliquidation.
