A BILL

To exempt woven fiberglass mesh fabric from certain quotas.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. WOVEN FIBERGLASS MESH FABRIC.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
5 sion of law, the quota imposed under category 622 estab-
6 lished pursuant to the Committee for the Implementation
7 of Textile Agreements (CITA) with respect to certain tex-
8 tile and apparel articles shall not apply to woven fiberglass
9 mesh fabric provided for in subheading 7019.40.40 of the
10 Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States.

11 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The provision in subsection
12 (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from warehouse

1 for consumption, on or after the 15th day after the date
2 of the enactment of this Act.
