## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on certain thin fiberglass sheets.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN FIBERGLASS SHEETS.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
7 new heading:

“	9902.70.19		Certain thin fiberglass sheets, known as 'serim' (provided for in subheading 7019.32.00) .....		Free		Free		No change		On or before 12/31/2009	”.

8 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
9 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
