which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Finance

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## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on certain woven fabrics  
of cotton, containing less than 85 percent by weight  
of cotton.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN WOVEN FABRICS OF COTTON, CON-**  
4 **TAINING LESS THAN 85 PERCENT BY WEIGHT**  
5 **OF COTTON.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
7 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
8 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
9 new heading:

“	9902.52.10	Woven fabrics of cotton, containing less than 85 percent by weight of cotton, mixed mainly or solely with man-made fibers, weighing not more than 200 g/m <sup>2</sup> , the foregoing bleached and other than plain weave fabrics or 3-thread or 4-thread twill (including cross twill) fabrics (provided for in subheading 5210.29) .....	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2009	”.
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1           (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by  
2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from  
3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after  
4 the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
