A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to conduct feasibility studies to identify opportunities to increase the surface flows of the Rio Grande, Canadian, and Pecos Rivers in the State of New Mexico, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “New Mexico Rivers
5 Feasibility Studies Act of 2006”.

1 **SEC. 2. RIO GRANDE, CANADIAN, AND PECOS RIVERS FEA-**
2 **SIBILITY STUDY.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of the Interior, act-
4 ing through the Commissioner of Reclamation (referred to
5 in this Act as the “Secretary”), in coordination with the
6 State of New Mexico, shall, in accordance with this Act
7 and any other applicable law, conduct feasibility studies
8 to identify opportunities to increase the surface flows of
9 the Rio Grande, Canadian, and Pecos Rivers in the State
10 of New Mexico.

11 (b) REPORT.—Not later than 2 years after the date
12 of enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall submit to
13 the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources of the
14 Senate and the Committee on Resources of the House of
15 Representatives a report that describes the results of the
16 feasibility studies conducted under subsection (a).

17 (c) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There is
18 authorized to be appropriated to the Secretary to carry
19 out this Act \$3,000,000.
