1 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF PERIOD FOR EXPENDITURE OF**
2 **ADDITIONAL SSBG ALLOTMENT FOR NEC-**
3 **CESSARY EXPENSES RELATED TO THE CON-**
4 **SEQUENCES OF HURRICANE KATRINA AND**
5 **OTHER HURRICANES IN THE GULF OF MEX-**
6 **ICO IN 2005.**

7 Notwithstanding section 2002(c) of the Social Secu-
8 rity Act (42 U.S.C. 1397a(c)), the additional allotment for
9 the State of Louisiana from amounts appropriated under
10 the heading “Social Services Block Grant”, under the
11 heading “Administration for Children and Families”,
12 under the heading “Department of Health and Human
13 Services” of the Department of Defense, Emergency Sup-
14 plemental Appropriations to Address Hurricanes in the
15 Gulf of Mexico, and Pandemic Influenza Act, 2006 (Public
16 Law 109–148, 119 Stat. 2768) shall remain available for
17 obligation through September 30, 2008.
