## A BILL

To amend the Trade Sanctions Reform and Export Enhancement Act of 2000 to clarify allowable payment terms for sales of agricultural commodities and products to Cuba.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. CLARIFICATION OF PAYMENT TERMS FOR**  
4                       **SALES OF AGRICULTURAL COMMODITIES**  
5                       **AND PRODUCTS TO CUBA.**

6       Section 908(b)(1)(A) of the Trade Sanctions Reform  
7       and Export Enhancement Act of 2000 (22 U.S.C.  
8       7207(b)(1)(A)) is amended by inserting before the period

1 at the end the following: “, which in this subsection means  
2 the payment by the purchaser of an agricultural com-  
3 modity or product and the receipt of the payment by the  
4 seller prior to—

5                           “(i) the transfer of title of the com-  
6                           modity or product to the purchaser; and

7                           “(ii) the release of control of the com-  
8                           modity or product to the purchaser.”.
