1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Morley Nelson Snake
3 River Birds of Prey National Conservation Area Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. RENAMING OF SNAKE RIVER BIRDS OF PREY NA-**
5 **TIONAL CONSERVATION AREA.**

6 (a) RENAMING.—Public Law 103–64 is amended—

7 (1) in section 2(2) (16 U.S.C. 460iii–1(2)), by
8 inserting “Morley Nelson” before “Snake River
9 Birds of Prey National Conservation Area”; and

10 (2) in section 3(a)(1) (16 U.S.C. 460iii–
11 2(a)(1)), by inserting “Morley Nelson” before
12 “Snake River Birds of Prey National Conservation
13 Area”.

14 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
15 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
16 States to the Snake River Birds of Prey National Con-
17 servation Area shall be deemed to be a reference to the
18 Morley Nelson Snake River Birds of Prey National Con-
19 servation Area.

20 (c) TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS.—Public Law 103–64
21 is further amended—

22 (1) in section 3(a)(1) (16 U.S.C. 460iii–
23 2(a)(1)), by striking “(hereafter referred to as the
24 ‘conservation area’)”; and

25 (2) in section 4 (16 U.S.C. 460iii–3)—

1 (A) in subsection (a)(2), by striking “Con-
2 servation Area” and inserting “conservation
3 area”; and

4 (B) in subsection (d), by striking “Visitors
5 Center” and inserting “visitors center”.
