A BILL

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

4 The facility of the United States Postal Service lo-
5 cated at 8200 South Vermont Avenue in Los Angeles,
6 California, shall be known and designated as the “Ser-
7 geant First Class John Marshall Post Office Building”.

1 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

2 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
3 paper, or other record of the United States to the facility
4 referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be a reference
5 to the “Sergeant First Class John Marshall Post Office
6 Building”.
