A BILL

To extend the water service contract for the Ainsworth Unit, Sandhills Division, Pick-Sloan Missouri Basin Program, Nebraska.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AINSWORTH UNIT, SANDHILLS DIVISION, PICK-**
4 **SLOAN MISSOURI BASIN PROGRAM.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of the Interior shall
6 extend for the period described in subsection (b) the water

1 service contract for the Ainsworth Unit, Sandhills Divi-
2 sion, Pick-Sloan Missouri Basin Program, Nebraska, con-
3 sisting of—

4 (1) the water service contract entered into by
5 the Secretary of the Interior under—

6 (A) section 9(e) of the Reclamation Project
7 Act of 1939 (43 U.S.C. 485h(e));

8 (B) section 9(c) of the Act of December
9 22, 1944 (58 Stat. 887, chapter 665);

10 (C) the Act of August 21, 1954 (68 Stat.
11 757, chapter 781); and

12 (D) the Act of May 18, 1956 (70 Stat.
13 160, chapter 285); and

14 (2) the water service contract for the set project
15 located in Cherry, Brown, and Rock Counties, Ne-
16 braska, for the use of a part of the waters of the
17 Snake River, a tributary of the Niobrara River.

18 (b) PERIOD OF EXTENSION.—The water service con-
19 tract described in subsection (a) shall be extended for 4
20 years after the date on which the contract expires under
21 the water service contract and law in existence before the
22 date of enactment of this Act.

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
