Mr. LOTT submitted the following concurrent resolution; which was considered and agreed to

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Authorizing the printing of a revised edition of a pocket version of the United States Constitution and other publications.

1 *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*
2 *concurring),*

3 **SECTION 1. POCKET VERSION OF THE UNITED STATES**
4 **CONSTITUTION.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The 22nd edition of the pocket
6 version of the United States Constitution shall be printed
7 as a Senate document under the direction of the Joint
8 Committee on Printing.

9 (b) ADDITIONAL COPIES.—In addition to the usual
10 number, there shall be printed the lesser of—

1 (1) 550,000 copies of the document, of which
2 440,000 copies shall be for the use of the House of
3 Representatives, 100,000 copies shall be for the use
4 of the Senate, and 10,000 copies shall be for the use
5 of the Joint Committee on Printing; or

6 (2) such number of copies of the document as
7 does not exceed a total production and printing cost
8 of \$198,000 with distribution to be allocated in the
9 same proportion as described in paragraph (1), ex-
10 cept that in no case shall the number of copies be
11 less than 1 for each Member of Congress.

12 **SEC. 2. OUR FLAG.**

13 (a) IN GENERAL.—The 2006 revised edition of the
14 publication entitled “Our Flag” shall be printed as a Sen-
15 ate document under the direction of the Joint Committee
16 on Printing.

17 (b) ADDITIONAL COPIES.—In addition to the usual
18 number, there shall be printed the lesser of—

19 (1) 550,000 copies of the document, of which
20 440,000 copies shall be for the use of the House of
21 Representatives, 100,000 copies shall be for the use
22 of the Senate, and 10,000 copies shall be for the use
23 of the Joint Committee on Printing; or

24 (2) such number of copies of the document as
25 does not exceed a total production and printing cost

1 of \$215,000 with distribution to be allocated in the
2 same proportion as described in paragraph (1), ex-
3 cept that in no case shall the number of copies be
4 less than 1 for each Member of Congress.

5 **SEC. 3. A BOTANIC GARDEN FOR THE NATION.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—There shall be printed as a Senate
7 document under the direction of the Joint Committee on
8 Printing the book entitled “A Botanic Garden for the Na-
9 tion”, prepared by the United States Botanic Gardens.

10 (b) SPECIFICATIONS.—The Senate document de-
11 scribed in subsection (a) shall include illustrations and
12 shall be in the style, form, manner, and binding as di-
13 rected by the Joint Committee on Printing.

14 (c) NUMBER OF COPIES.—In addition to the usual
15 number of copies, there shall be printed with suitable bind-
16 ing the lesser of—

17 (1) 3,075 copies of the document, of which 725
18 copies shall be for the use of the Senate and 1,470
19 for the use the House of Representatives with dis-
20 tribution determined by the Joint Committee on
21 Printing, 880 copies for the use of the Botanic Gar-
22 dens with distribution determined by the Joint Com-
23 mittee of Congress on the Library; or

1 (2) a number of copies that does not have a
2 total production and printing cost of more than
3 \$102,000.
