## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To extend the life of the Joint Congressional Committee on Inaugural Ceremonies and the provisions of S. Con. Res. 93 and S. Con. Res. 94 of the One Hundred Eighth Congress.

1        *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*  
2        *concurring)*, That effective from January 3, 2005, the  
3        joint committee created by Senate Concurrent Resolution  
4        94 (108th Congress), to make the necessary arrangements  
5        for the inauguration, is hereby continued with the same  
6        power and authority provided for in that resolution.

7        SEC. 2. Effective from January 4, 2005, the provi-  
8        sions of Senate Concurrent Resolution 93 (108th Con-

1 gress), to authorize the rotunda of the United States Cap-  
2 itol to be used in connection with the proceedings and  
3 ceremonies for the inauguration of the President-elect and  
4 the Vice President-elect of the United States, are contin-  
5 ued with the same power and authority provided for in  
6 that resolution.
