## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To correct the enrollment of H.R. 1268.

1       *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*  
2 *concurring)*, That in the enrollment of H.R. 1268, an Act  
3 making emergency supplemental appropriations for the  
4 fiscal year ending September 30, 2005, and for other pur-  
5 poses, the Clerk of the House of Representatives is hereby  
6 authorized and directed to correct section 502 of title V  
7 of division B so that clause (ii) of section 106(d)(2)(B)  
8 of the American Competitiveness in the Twenty-first Cen-  
9 tury Act of 2000 (Public Law 106–313; 8 U.S.C. 1153  
10 note), as amended by such section 502, reads as follows:

11               “(ii) MAXIMUM.—The total number of  
12               visas made available under paragraph (1) from

1 unused visas from the fiscal years 2001 through  
2 2004 may not exceed 50,000.”.
