CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*
2 *concurring)*, That when the Senate recesses or adjourns
3 at the close of business on Thursday, September 1, or on
4 Friday, September 2, 2005, on a motion offered pursuant
5 to this concurrent resolution by its Majority Leader or his
6 designee, it stand recessed or adjourned until 12 noon on
7 Tuesday, September 6, 2005, or until the time of any re-
8 assembly pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolu-
9 tion, whichever occurs first; and that when the House ad-
10 journs on the legislative day of Friday, September 2,
11 2005, on a motion offered pursuant to this concurrent res-
12 olution by its Majority Leader or his designee, it stand
13 adjourned until 2 p.m. on Tuesday, September 6, 2005,
14 or until the time of any reassembly pursuant to section
15 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs first.

16 SEC. 2. The Majority Leader of the Senate and the
17 Speaker of the House, or their respective designees, acting
18 jointly after consultation with the Minority Leader of the
19 Senate and the Minority Leader of the House, shall notify

1 the Members of the Senate and House, respectively, to re-
2 assemble at such place and time as they may designate
3 whenever, in their opinion, the public interest shall war-
4 rant it.
