CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Authorizing the remains of Rosa Parks to lie in honor in
the rotunda of the Capitol.

1 *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*
2 *concurring)*, That, in recognition of the historic contribu-
3 tions of Rosa Parks, her remains be permitted to lie in
4 honor in the rotunda of the Capitol from October 30 to
5 October 31, 2005, so that the citizens of the United States
6 may pay their last respects to this great American. The
7 Architect of the Capitol, under the direction and super-

- 1 vision of the President pro tempore of the Senate and the
- 2 Speaker of the House of Representatives, shall take all
- 3 necessary steps for the accomplishment of that purpose.
