CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Directing the Joint Committee on the Library to procure a statue of Rosa Parks for placement in the Capitol.

1 *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*
2 *concurring),*

3 **SECTION 1. PROCUREMENT OF A STATUE OF ROSA PARKS.**

4 The Joint Committee on the Library shall procure
5 a statue of Rosa Parks and cause such statue to be placed
6 in a suitable location in the Capitol, as determined by the
7 Joint Committee on the Library.

8 **SEC. 2. PAYMENT OF EXPENSES.**

9 The expenses incurred by the Joint Committee on the
10 Library in carrying out this concurrent resolution shall be

1 paid out of the miscellaneous items account within the
2 contingency fund of the Senate on vouchers approved by
3 the Joint Committee on the Library and signed by the
4 chairman and vice-chairman of the Joint Committee.
