## JOINT RESOLUTION

Providing for the appointment of Phillip Frost as a citizen regent of the Board of Regents of the Smithsonian Institution.

1       *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*  
2       *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3       That, in accordance with section 5581 of the Revised Stat-  
4       utes (20 U.S.C. 43), the vacancy on the Board of Regents  
5       of the Smithsonian Institution, in the class other than  
6       Members of Congress, resulting from the retirement of  
7       Manuel L. Ibáñez, is filled by the appointment of Phillip  
8       Frost of Miami Beach, Florida. The appointment is for

- 1 a term of 6 years, beginning upon the date of enactment
- 2 of this joint resolution.
