RESOLUTION

Expressing the sense of the Senate on the continued presence of United States troops in Iraq until at least 2009.

- 1 *Resolved*, That it is the sense of the Senate that—
- 2 (1) the members of the Armed Forces deserve
- 3 the enormous respect and support of the Senate and
- 4 the American people for the sacrifices that they are
- 5 making on behalf of our country; and
- 6 (2) the President’s intention, as stated on
- 7 March 21, 2006, that “future Presidents” will deter-
- 8 mine whether to keep members of the Armed Forces
- 9 in Iraq undermines the preparedness of the United

- 2 not be supported.
