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## AN ACT

To authorize appropriations for the San Gabriel Basin  
Restoration Fund.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2        *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3        **SECTION 1. SAN GABRIEL BASIN RESTORATION FUND.**

4        Section 110 of division B of the Miscellaneous Approp-  
5        priations Act, 2001 (114 Stat. 2763A–222), as enacted  
6        into law by section 1(a)(4) of the Consolidated Appropria-  
7        tions Act, 2001 (Public Law 106–554, as amended by  
8        Public Law 107–66), is further amended—

9                (1) in subsection (a)(3)(B), by inserting after  
10        clause (iii) the following:

1           “(iv) NON-FEDERAL MATCH.—After  
2           \$85,000,000 has cumulatively been appro-  
3           priated under subsection (d)(1), the re-  
4           mainder of Federal funds appropriated  
5           under subsection (d) shall be subject to the  
6           following matching requirement:

7                   “(I) SAN GABRIEL BASIN WATER  
8                   QUALITY AUTHORITY.—The San Ga-  
9                   briel Basin Water Quality Authority  
10                  shall be responsible for providing a 35  
11                  percent non-Federal match for Fed-  
12                  eral funds made available to the Au-  
13                  thority under this Act.

14                  “(II) CENTRAL BASIN MUNICIPAL  
15                  WATER DISTRICT.—The Central Basin  
16                  Municipal Water District shall be re-  
17                  sponsible for providing a 35 percent  
18                  non-Federal match for Federal funds  
19                  made available to the District under  
20                  this Act.”;

21           (2) in subsection (a), by adding at the end the  
22           following:

23                   “(4) INTEREST ON FUNDS IN RESTORATION  
24                   FUND.—No amounts appropriated above the cumu-  
25                   lative amount of \$85,000,000 to the Restoration

1 Fund under subsection (d)(1) shall be invested by  
2 the Secretary of the Treasury in interest-bearing se-  
3 curities of the United States.”; and

4 (3) by amending subsection (d) to read as fol-  
5 lows:

6 “(d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—

7 “(1) IN GENERAL.—There is authorized to be  
8 appropriated to the Restoration Fund established  
9 under subsection (a) \$146,200,000. Such funds shall  
10 remain available until expended.

11 “(2) SET-ASIDE.—Of the amounts appropriated  
12 under paragraph (1), no more than \$21,200,000  
13 shall be made available to carry out the Central  
14 Basin Water Quality Project.”.
