A BILL

To redesignate the National Institute on Drug Abuse as the National Institute on Diseases of Addiction, and to redesignate the National Institute on Alcohol Abuse and Alcoholism as the National Institute on Alcohol Disorders and Health.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “NIDA and NIAAA
5 Name Redesignation Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REDESIGNATION OF THE NATIONAL INSTITUTE ON**
2 **DRUG ABUSE AS THE NATIONAL INSTITUTE**
3 **ON DISEASES OF ADDICTION.**

4 (a) REDESIGNATION.—The agency of the National
5 Institutes of Health designated as the National Institute
6 on Drug Abuse is redesignated as the National Institute
7 on Diseases of Addiction.

8 (b) REFERENCES IN PUBLIC HEALTH SERVICE
9 ACT.—The Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 201 et
10 seq.) is amended—

11 (1) in sections 401(b)(13), 464L(a), 501(d),
12 501(k)(3), 507(b)(5), 519B(c)(1)(B), 530, and
13 1918(a)(8)(B), by striking the term “National Insti-
14 tute on Drug Abuse” each place such term appears
15 and inserting “National Institute on Diseases of Ad-
16 diction”;

17 (2) in section 464H(b)(5), by striking “Na-
18 tional Institute of Drug Abuse” and inserting “Na-
19 tional Institute on Diseases of Addiction”;

20 (3) in the heading of subpart 15 of part C of
21 title IV, by striking “**National Institute on**
22 **Drug Abuse**” and inserting “**National Insti-**
23 **tute on Diseases of Addiction**”; and

24 (4) in the heading of section 513, by striking
25 “NATIONAL INSTITUTE ON DRUG ABUSE” and insert-

1 ing “NATIONAL INSTITUTE ON DISEASES OF ADDIC-
2 TION”.

3 (c) OTHER REFERENCES.—Any reference in any law,
4 regulation, document, record, or other paper of the United
5 States to the National Institute on Drug Abuse shall be
6 considered to be a reference to the National Institute on
7 Diseases of Addiction.

8 **SEC. 3. REDESIGNATION OF THE NATIONAL INSTITUTE ON**
9 **ALCOHOL ABUSE AND ALCOHOLISM AS THE**
10 **NATIONAL INSTITUTE ON ALCOHOL DIS-**
11 **ORDERS AND HEALTH.**

12 (a) REDESIGNATION.—The agency of the National
13 Institutes of Health designated as the National Institute
14 on Alcohol Abuse and Alcoholism is redesignated as the
15 National Institute on Alcohol Disorders and Health.

16 (b) REFERENCES IN PUBLIC HEALTH SERVICE
17 ACT.—The Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 201 et
18 seq.) is amended—

19 (1) in sections 208(g), 401(b)(12), 464H(a),
20 464P(a)(7), 501(d), 501(k)(3), 507(b)(5),
21 519B(c)(1)(B), and 519C(g)(2), by striking the
22 term “National Institute on Alcohol Abuse and Alco-
23 holism” each place such term appears and inserting
24 “National Institute on Alcohol Disorders and
25 Health”;

1 (2) in the heading of subpart 14 of part C of
2 title IV, by striking “**National Institute on Al-**
3 **cohol Abuse and Alcoholism**” and inserting
4 “**National Institute on Alcohol Disorders**
5 **and Health**”; and

6 (3) in section 530, by striking “National Insti-
7 tute of Alcohol Abuse and Alcoholism” and inserting
8 “National Institute on Alcohol Disorders and
9 Health”.

10 (c) OTHER REFERENCES.—Any reference in any law,
11 regulation, document, record, or other paper of the United
12 States to the National Institute on Alcohol Abuse and Al-
13 coholism shall be considered to be a reference to the Na-
14 tional Institute on Alcohol Disorders and Health.
