1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. METROPOLITAN CITIES.**

2 Paragraph (4) of section 102(a) of the Housing and
3 Community Development Act of 1974 (42 U.S.C. 5302)
4 is amended by adding at the end the following new sen-
5 tence: “Notwithstanding any other provision of this para-
6 graph, with respect to any fiscal year beginning after the
7 date of the enactment of this sentence, the cities of Alton
8 and Granite City, Illinois, shall be considered metropolitan
9 cities for purposes of this title.”.
