## A BILL

To designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 630 Northeast Killingsworth Avenue in Portland, Oregon, as the “Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Post Office”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DR. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. POST OFFICE.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States  
5 Postal Service located at 630 Northeast Killingsworth Av-  
6 enue in Portland, Oregon, shall be known and designated  
7 as the “Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Post Office”.

1           (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-  
2 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United  
3 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall  
4 be deemed to be a reference to the “Dr. Martin Luther  
5 King, Jr. Post Office”.
