Mr. BURGESS introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce

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## A BILL

To include B20 biodiesel blends as an alternative fuel for corporate average fuel economy purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. BIODIESEL AS ALTERNATIVE FUEL FOR CAFE**

4 **PURPOSES.**

5 Section 32901(a) of title 49, United States Code, is  
6 amended—

7 (1) in paragraph (1), by redesignating subpara-  
8 graphs (J) and (K) as subparagraphs (K) and (L),  
9 respectively, and inserting after subparagraph (I)  
10 the following:

1 “(J) B20 biodiesel blend;” and

2 (2) by redesignating paragraphs (7) through  
3 (16) as paragraphs (9) through (18), respectively,  
4 and insert after paragraph (6) the following:

5 “(7) ‘biodiesel’ means the monoalkyl esters of  
6 long chain fatty acids derived from plant or animal  
7 matter which meet—

8 “(A) the registration requirements for  
9 fuels and fuel additives established by the Envi-  
10 ronmental Protection Agency under section 211  
11 of the Clean Air Act (42 U.S.C. 7545); and

12 “(B) the requirements of the American So-  
13 ciety of Testing and Materials D6751.

14 “(8) ‘B20 biodiesel blend’ means a mixture of  
15 biodiesel and diesel fuel approximately 20 percent of  
16 the content of which is biodiesel, and commonly  
17 known as ‘B20’.”

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
