A BILL

To authorize appropriations for the Bureau of Reclamation to carry out the Lower Colorado River Multi-Species Conservation Program in the States of Arizona, California, and Nevada, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 *This Act may be cited as the “Lower Colorado River*
5 *Multi-Species Conservation Program Act”.*

6 **SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.**

7 *In this Act:*

8 (1) *LOWER COLORADO RIVER MULTI-SPECIES*
9 *CONSERVATION PROGRAM.—The term “Lower Colo-*
10 *rado River Multi-Species Conservation Program” or*
11 *“LCR MSCP” means the cooperative effort on the*
12 *Lower Colorado River between Federal and non-Fed-*
13 *eral entities in Arizona, California, and Nevada ap-*
14 *proved by the Secretary of the Interior on April 2,*
15 *2005.*

16 (2) *LOWER COLORADO RIVER.—The term “Lower*
17 *Colorado River” means the Colorado River from Lake*
18 *Mead to the Southerly International Boundary with*
19 *Mexico, including its historic floodplain and its*
20 *mainstem reservoirs to their full pool elevations.*

21 (3) *SECRETARY.—The term “Secretary” means*
22 *the Secretary of the Interior.*

23 (4) *STATES.—The term “States” means each of*
24 *the States of Arizona, California, and Nevada.*

1 **SEC. 3. IMPLEMENTATION AND WATER ACCOUNTING.**

2 (a) *IN GENERAL.*—*The Secretary is authorized to par-*
3 *ticipate in the Lower Colorado River Multi-Species Con-*
4 *servation Program.*

5 (b) *WATER ACCOUNTING.*—*The Secretary is authorized*
6 *to enter into an agreement with the States providing for*
7 *the use of water from the Lower Colorado River for habitat*
8 *creation and maintenance.*

9 **SEC. 4. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

10 (a) *IN GENERAL.*—*There is authorized to be appro-*
11 *priated to the Secretary such sums as may be necessary to*
12 *participate in the Lower Colorado River Multi-Species Con-*
13 *servation Program, to remain available until expended.*

14 (b) *NONREIMBURSABLE AND NONRETURNABLE.*—*All*
15 *amounts appropriated to and expended by the Secretary for*
16 *the LCR MSCP shall be nonreimbursable and nonreturn-*
17 *able.*
