3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF CHARLES GEORGE DEPART-**
4 **MENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS MEDICAL CEN-**
5 **TER.**

6 (a) DESIGNATION.—The Department of Veterans Af-
7 fairs Medical Center located at 1100 Tunnel Road, Ashe-
8 ville, North Carolina, shall after the date of the enactment

1 of this Act be known and designated as the “Charles
2 George Department of Veterans Affairs Medical Center”.

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in any law, regula-
4 tion, map, document, record, or other paper of the United
5 States to the medical center referred to in subsection (a)
6 shall be considered to be a reference to the Charles George
7 Department of Veterans Affairs Medical Center.
