## A BILL

To prevent Members of Congress from receiving the automatic pay adjustment scheduled to take effect in 2008.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Members of Congress  
5 Personal Fiscal Responsibility Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. ELIMINATION OF AUTOMATIC PAY ADJUSTMENT**

7 **FOR MEMBERS OF CONGRESS IN 2008.**

8 For purposes of the provision of law amended by sec-  
9 tion 704(a)(2)(B) of the Ethics Reform Act of 1989 (5

1 U.S.C. 5318 note), no adjustment under section 5303 of  
2 title 5, United States Code, shall be considered to have  
3 taken effect in fiscal year 2008 in the rates of basic pay  
4 for the statutory pay systems.
