3 **SECTION 1. E. ARTHUR GRAY POST OFFICE BUILDING.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
5 Postal Service located at 20 Sussex Street in Port Jervis,
6 New York, shall be known and designated as the “E. Ar-
7 thur Gray Post Office Building”.

8 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
9 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United

1 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
2 be deemed to be a reference to the “E. Arthur Gray Post
3 Office Building”.
