A BILL

To designate a portion of Interstate Route 395 located in Baltimore, Maryland, as “Cal Ripken Way”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

4 The portion of Interstate Route 395 located in Balti-
5 more, Maryland, beginning at the junction of Interstate
6 Routes 395 and 95 and ending at Conway Street shall
7 be known and designated as “Cal Ripken Way”.

1 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

2 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
3 paper, or other record of the United States to the portion
4 of Interstate Route 395 referred to in section 1 shall be
5 deemed to be a reference to the “Cal Ripken Way”.
