3 **SECTION 1. DENNIS P. COLLINS POST OFFICE BUILDING.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
5 Postal Service located at 570 Broadway in Bayonne, New
6 Jersey, shall be known and designated as the “Dennis P.
7 Collins Post Office Building”.

1 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
2 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
3 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
4 be deemed to be a reference to the “Dennis P. Collins Post
5 Office Building”.
