AN ACT

To provide for the establishment of a memorial within Kalaupapa National Historical Park located on the island of Molokai, in the State of Hawaii, to honor and perpetuate the memory of those individuals who were forcibly relocated to the Kalaupapa Peninsula from 1866 to 1969, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Kalaupapa Memorial
5 Act of 2008”.

6 **SEC. 2. ESTABLISHMENT OF MEMORIAL WITHIN**
7 **KALAUPAPA NATIONAL HISTORICAL PARK.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Interior shall
9 authorize Ka ‘Ohana O Kalaupapa, a non-profit organiza-
10 tion consisting of patient residents at Kalaupapa National
11 Historical Park, and their family members and friends,
12 to establish a memorial at a suitable location or locations
13 approved by the Secretary at Kalawao or Kalaupapa with-
14 in the boundaries of Kalaupapa National Historical Park
15 located on the island of Molokai, in the State of Hawaii,
16 to honor and perpetuate the memory of those individuals
17 who were forcibly relocated to Kalaupapa Peninsula from
18 1866 to 1969.

19 (b) DESIGN.—

20 (1) IN GENERAL.—The memorial authorized by
21 subsection (a) shall—

22 (A) display in an appropriate manner the
23 names of the first 5,000 individuals sent to the
24 Kalaupapa Peninsula between 1866 and 1896,
25 most of whom lived at Kalawao; and

1 (B) display in an appropriate manner the
2 names of the approximately 3,000 individuals
3 who arrived at Kalaupapa in the second part of
4 its history, when most of the community was
5 concentrated on the Kalaupapa side of the pe-
6 ninsula.

7 (2) APPROVAL.—The location, size, design, and
8 inscriptions of the memorial authorized by sub-
9 section (a) shall be subject to the approval of the
10 Secretary of the Interior.

11 (c) FUNDING.—Ka ‘Ohana O Kalaupapa, a nonprofit
12 organization, shall be solely responsible for acceptance of
13 contributions for and payment of the expenses associated
14 with the establishment of the memorial.
