1 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT TO THE INTERNATIONAL CENTER**
2 **ACT.**

3 The first section of the International Center Act
4 (Public Law 90–553; 82 Stat. 958) is amended by adding
5 at the end the following new sentence: “Notwithstanding
6 the foregoing limitations, the property identified by the
7 District of Columbia as tax lots 803, 804, 805, and 806
8 within the area described in this section may be leased
9 or subleased to an entity other than a foreign government
10 or international organization, so long as the Secretary
11 maintains the right to approve the occupant and the in-
12 tended use of the property.”.
