## A BILL

To extend the temporary suspension of duty on yttrium oxides having a purity of at least 99.9 percent.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. YTTRIUM OXIDES HAVING A PURITY OF AT**  
4 **LEAST 99.9 PERCENT.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.02.21 of the Har-  
6 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States is amended  
7 by striking “12/31/2006” and inserting “12/31/2010”.

8 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—

9 (1) IN GENERAL.—The amendment made by  
10 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered,

1 or withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on  
2 or after the 15th day after the date of the enact-  
3 ment of this Act.

4 (2) RETROACTIVE APPLICATION.—Notwith-  
5 standing section 514 of the Tariff Act of 1930 (19  
6 U.S.C. 1514) or any other provision of law, upon  
7 proper request filed with U.S. Customs and Border  
8 Protection before the date that is 90 days after the  
9 date of the enactment of this section, any entry, or  
10 withdrawal from warehouse for consumption of an  
11 article described in heading 9902.02.21 of the Har-  
12 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (as  
13 amended by subsection (a)) that was made—

14 (A) after December 31, 2006, and

15 (B) before the date of the enactment of  
16 this section,

17 shall be liquidated or reliquidated as though the  
18 amendment made by subsection (a) applied to such  
19 entry or withdrawal.

20 (3) PROPER REQUESTS.—For purposes of para-  
21 graph (2), a proper request means a request for liq-  
22 uidation or reliquidation that contains sufficient in-  
23 formation to enable the U.S. Customs and Border  
24 Protection—

25 (A) to locate the entry; or

1 (B) to reconstruct the entry if it cannot be  
2 located.
