10 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.02.47 of the Har-
11 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
12 Cuprate (3-), [2-[[[[3-[[4-[[2-[2-(ethenylsulfonyl)ethoxy]-

1 ethyl]amino]-6-fluoro-1,3,5-triazin-2-yl]amino]-2-
2 (hydroxy- κ O)-5-sulfophenyl]azo- κ N2]phenyl methyl]azo-
3 κ N1]- 4-sulfobenzoato(5-)- κ O], trisodium) is amended by
4 striking the date in the effective period column and insert-
5 ing “12/31/2011”.

6 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
7 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
8 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
9 the date of the enactment of this Act.
