3 **SECTION 1. CHILD CARRIERS, CHAIN TENSION ADJUSTORS,**
4 **CHAIN COVERS, AND CERTAIN OTHER ARTI-**
5 **CLES DESIGNED FOR USE ON BICYCLES.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.24.66 of the Har-
7 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
8 child carriers, chain tension adjustors, chain covers, and
9 certain other articles designed for use on bicycles) is

1 amended by striking “12/31/2009” and inserting “12/31/
2 2011”.

3 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by
4 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
5 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
6 the date of the enactment of this Act.
