Mr. HOLT (for himself, Mr. HINOJOSA, Mr. EHLERS, and Mr. MARKEY) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Education and Labor

A BILL

To establish in the Department of Education an Assistant Secretary for International and Foreign Language Education and an Office of International and Foreign Language Education.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “International Edu-
5 cation Leadership Act of 2008”.

1 **SEC. 2. ESTABLISHMENT OF ASSISTANT SECRETARY FOR**
2 **INTERNATIONAL AND FOREIGN LANGUAGE**
3 **EDUCATION.**

4 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Section 202(b)(1) of the Depart-
5 ment of Education Organization Act (20 U.S.C.
6 3412(b)(1)) is amended—

7 (1) in subparagraph (E), by striking “and” at
8 the end;

9 (2) by redesignating subparagraph (F) as sub-
10 paragraph (G); and

11 (3) by inserting after subparagraph (E) the fol-
12 lowing:

13 “(F) an Assistant Secretary for International
14 and Foreign Language Education; and”.

15 (b) **FUNCTIONS.**—Section 202 of such Act is further
16 amended by adding at the end the following:

17 “(j) The Assistant Secretary for International and
18 Foreign Language Education—

19 “(1) shall be an individual with extensive back-
20 ground and experience in international and foreign
21 language education; and

22 “(2) notwithstanding any other provision of
23 law, shall report directly the Secretary.”.

24 (c) **CONFORMING AMENDMENT.**—Section 202(e) of
25 such Act is amended—

1 “(2) carry out the administration of all Depart-
2 ment programs on international and foreign lan-
3 guage education and research;

4 “(3) coordinate with related international and
5 foreign language education programs of other Fed-
6 eral departments and agencies; and

7 “(4) administer and coordinate the Department
8 of Education’s activities in international affairs.”.
