## A BILL

To extend the temporary suspension of duty on certain light absorbing photo dyes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN LIGHT ABSORBING PHOTO DYES.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.23.20 of the Har-  
5 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to  
6 Morpholine,4-[4,5-dihydro-4-[3-[5-hydroxy-1-methyl-3-  
7 (4-morpholinylcarbonyl)-1H-pyrazol-3-yl]-2-  
8 propenyldiene]-1-methyl-5-oxo-1H-pyrazol-3-yl]carbonyl]-,  
9 potassium salt; 1,4-benzenedisulfonic acid, 2-[4-[5-[1-  
10 (2,5-disulfophenyl)-1,5-dihydro-3-

1 [(methylamino)carbonyl]-5-oxo-4H-pyrazol-4-ylidene]-3-  
2 (2-oxo-1-pyrrolidinyl)- 1,3-pentadienyl]-5-hydroxy-3-  
3 [(methylamino)carbonyl]-1H-pyrazol-1-yl]-,  
4 pentapotassium salt) is amended by striking “12/31/  
5 2009” and inserting “12/31/2011”.

6 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
7 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from  
8 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after  
9 the date of the enactment of this Act.
