## A BILL

To amend the Peace Corps Act to provide continued funding for the Peace Corps, to increase the readjustment allowance for returning Peace Corps volunteers, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Peace Corps Reauthor-  
5       ization Act of 2008”.

6       **SEC. 2. FUNDING FOR THE PEACE CORPS.**

7       Section 3(b)(1) of the Peace Corps Act (22 U.S.C.  
8       2502(b)(1)) is amended—

1 (1) by striking “and”; and

2 (2) by inserting before the period at the end the  
3 following: “, \$400,000,000 for fiscal year 2009,  
4 \$500,000,000 for fiscal year 2010, \$600,000,000 for  
5 fiscal year 2011, and \$700,000,000 for fiscal year  
6 2012”.

7 **SEC. 3. READJUSTMENT ALLOWANCE FOR PEACE CORPS**  
8 **VOLUNTEERS.**

9 Section 5(c) of the Peace Corp Act (22 U.S.C.  
10 2504(c)) is amended, in the first sentence, by striking  
11 “\$125” and inserting “\$225”.
