## A BILL

To amend the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States to revise the classification of certain cigars.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN CIGARS.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 24 of the Harmonized  
5 Tariff Schedule of the United States is amended by strik-  
6 ing subheading 2402.10.80 and inserting the following  
7 new subheadings and superior text thereto, with such su-  
8 perior text having the same degree of indentation as the  
9 article description for subheading 2402.10.80 as in effect  
10 immediately before the enactment of this Act:

“	2402.10.80	Each valued 23¢ or over: Cigars certified as handmade .....	57¢/kg + 1.4%	Free (A, AU, BH, CA, CL, E, IL, J, MA, MX, P, SG)	\$9.92/kg + 25%	”.
	2402.10.90	Other .....	57¢/kg + 1.4%	Free (A, AU, BH, CA, CL, E, IL, J, MA, MX, P, SG)	\$9.92/kg + 25%	

1           (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
 2 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or  
 3 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after  
 4 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
