A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to eliminate the requirement for dependents to reside with members of the Armed Forces to be eligible for TRICARE Prime Remote.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Military Healthcare
5 for Dependents Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. ELIMINATION OF REQUIREMENTS FOR DEPENDENT**
2 **TO RESIDE WITH MEMBER OF THE ARMED**
3 **FORCES TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR TRICARE**
4 **PRIME REMOTE.**

5 Section 1079(p) of title 10, United States Code, is
6 amended—

7 (1) in paragraph (3)(A), by inserting “or is
8 not” before “residing”;

9 (2) in paragraph (3)(B), by striking “, if the
10 orders do not” and all that follows through “same
11 remote location”; and

12 (3) in paragraph (3)(C), by striking all that fol-
13 lows “30 days” and inserting a period.
