A BILL

To prohibit the purchase or lease of housing acquired using Federal loan or grant funds appropriated for the purchase and rehabilitation of foreclosed housing under the Neighborhood Stabilization Act of 2008 by any individual convicted under Federal or State law of a drug-dealing offense, a sex offense, or mortgage fraud.

3 **SECTION 1. RESIDENCY LIMITATIONS.**

4 No individual may purchase or lease any housing, or
5 any dwelling unit in any such housing, acquired using
6 Federal loan or grant funds Congress appropriates for the

1 purchase and rehabilitation of foreclosed housing under
2 the Neighborhood Stabilization Act of 2008 if such indi-
3 vidual has been convicted under Federal or State law of
4 a felony drug-dealing offense within the 5-year period pre-
5 ceding the date of the purchase or lease transaction, a sex
6 offense, or mortgage fraud.

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
