Mr. WALBERG introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Small Business

A BILL

To amend the Small Business Act to expand the ability of suburban areas to be HUBZones.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “HUBZone Equity for
5 Distressed Communities Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. EQUITY FOR SUBURBAN HUBZONES.**

7 Section 3(p)(4) of the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C.
8 632(p)(4)) is amended by adding at the end the following:

9 “(E) QUALIFIED SUBURBAN AREA.—The
10 term ‘qualified suburban area’ means any vil-

1 lage, city, town, economic development area
2 governed by a public authority, district, or
3 other unit of general local government—

4 “(i) located in a county that includes,
5 or is located in, a metropolitan statistical
6 area (as defined in section 143(k)(2)(B) of
7 the Internal Revenue Code of 1986); and

8 “(ii) that meets the income or unem-
9 ployment qualifications under subpara-
10 graph (B)(ii).”.
